Historic Bay St. Louis

L&N Train Depot

Standing proudly at 1928 Depot Way, the Bay St. Louis L&N Train Depot is far more than a picturesque building—it is a living chronicle of Mississippi’s Gulf Coast. Completed in 1929 in the Mission Revival style, with stucco walls, Moorish arches, and terracotta trim, the two-story structure replaced a 1876 wooden depot lost to fire. Today, it remains one of the most iconic train depots along the Gulf Coast, a designated Mississippi Landmark, and part of the Old Bay St. Louis Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places.

Originally constructed by the Louisville & Nashville Railroad, the depot marked Bay St. Louis as a key stop along a vital coastal rail line stretching from New Orleans to Mobile. Its opening celebration on April 20, 1929, drew crowds in the hundreds. For decades, it pulsed with the energy of daily life—commuters bound for New Orleans, children waving to engineers, and vendors selling pralines, fish sandwiches, and fried oysters through open train windows. For many, “meeting the train” became a cherished local ritual.

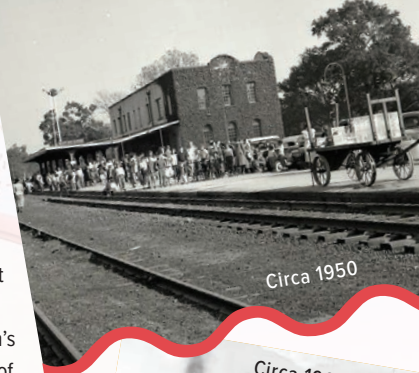
The depot hosted famed L&N passenger trains like the Pan-American, Humming Bird, and Gulf Wind, later joined by the Southern Railway's Crescent and Piedmont Limited. It carried troops during World War II, hosted carrier pigeon training on its grounds, and served as a lifeline for local commuters throughout the 1950s and 60s. Community memories recall club cars filled with card games and cocktail hours, ice-cold water at the station's fountain, and fathers timing their evening pickups by the sound of a distant train whistle.

The golden age of passenger rail faded with the rise of highways and air travel. By 1970, regular service ended. Amtrak's Sunset Limited returned briefly in the 1990s, but service was halted again in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina in 2005.

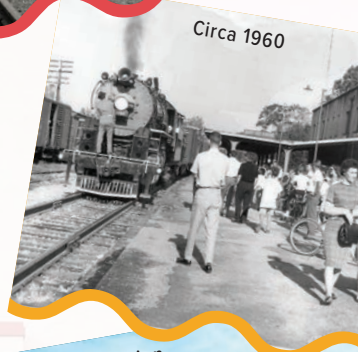
Yet the story didn't end there. Purchased by the City in 1991 and restored with the help of a \$1 million grant, the depot was reborn. It reopened in 1993 as a venue for public events and today houses the Hancock County Tourism Office, Visitor Center & Mardi Gras Museum, and the beloved Alice Moseley Folk Art Museum. Its cultural legacy even reached Hollywood as the backdrop of the 1966 film "This Property is Condemned," starring Robert Redford and Natalie Wood.

Through more than a century of storms, shifting transportation tides, and community change, the Bay St. Louis Depot remains a symbol of resilience, heritage, and connection. For locals and visitors alike, it is a place where history boards the train and never truly departs.

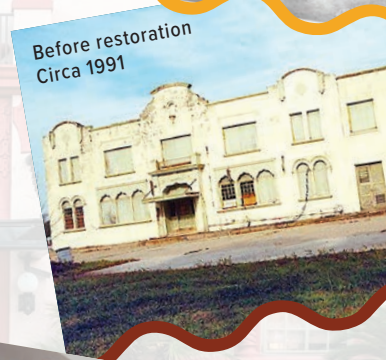
Excitingly, Amtrak service is returning in summer 2025. The new Mardi Gras line will connect New Orleans to Mobile with two trains running in each direction daily—totaling four passenger stops every day at the Bay St. Louis Depot. A new chapter in this historic station's legacy is just around the bend.

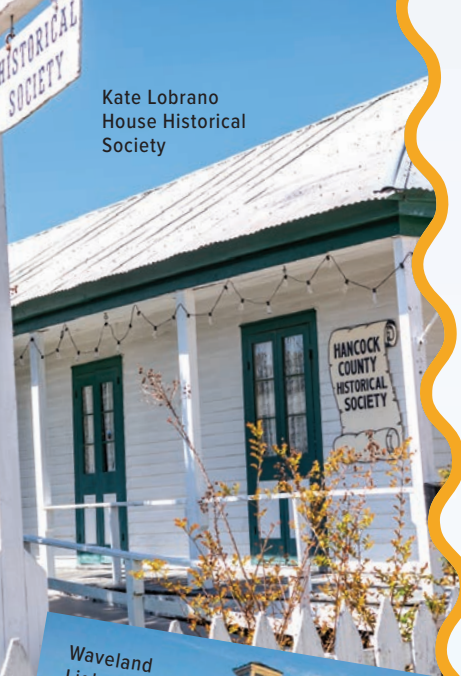

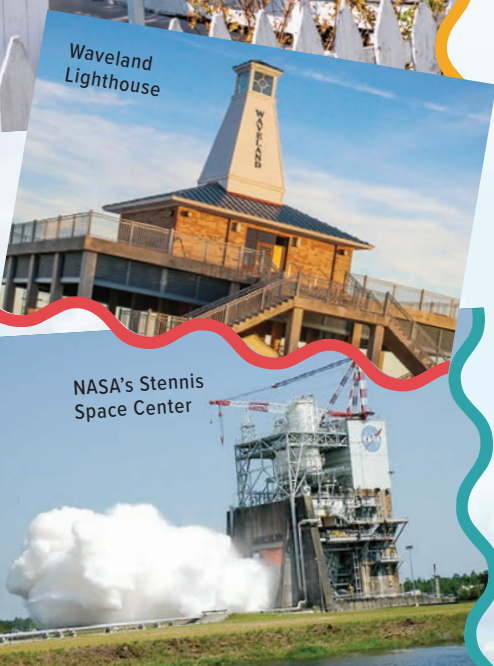


BAY ST. LOUIS

It's the perfect beach town if you want to avoid crowds and it's also home to a coastal state park. The 1.8-mile nature trail at Buccaneer State Park takes you through the wetlands with a chance to check out the local wildlife and has a waterpark and an 18-hole disc golf course to enjoy. And you don't want to miss a sundown beach stroll because wide-open sunsets are just more glorious in "The Hospitality City."

DIAMONDHEAD

Named after a volcanic tuff cone on the Hawaiian island of Oahu, the name was selected in hopes that it would attract quick-witted coastal residents or clever travelers looking to relocate. It seemed to work, as Diamondhead was deemed the smartest city in the state, with only three percent of its residents not possessing a high school diploma. Diamondhead is also a top choice for snowbirds looking to relocate due to its countless amenities.

In addition to these cities, Hancock County also incorporates Kiln and Pearlinton, two census-designated places that have an atmosphere all their own. Kiln (pronounced "Kill") is a local favorite, known for McLeod Park, Lazy Magnolia Brewery, and The Broke Spoke, a bar made famous by Brett Favre himself! Over in Pearlinton, get ready to blast off at INFINITY Science Center, a learning experience that's out of this world. Pearlinton is also home to the NASA's Stennis Space Center, NASA's primary rocket propulsion test site and the largest of its kind in America.

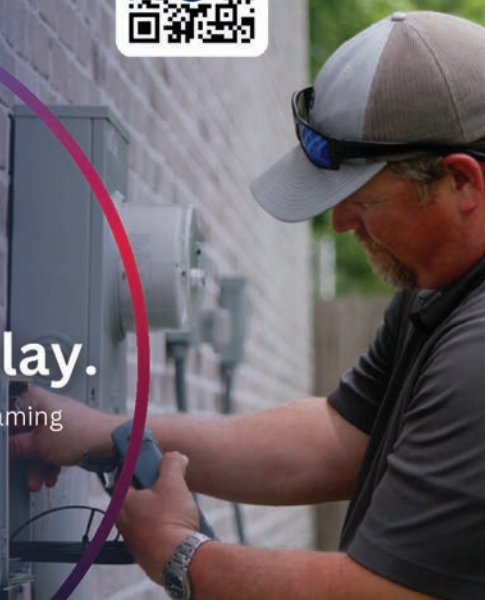

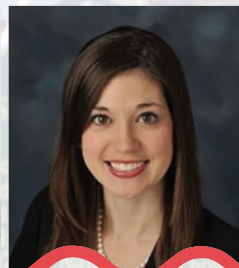
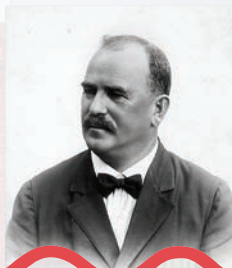

Hancock County Fair, Elves in the Park, and the Easter Egg-travaganza

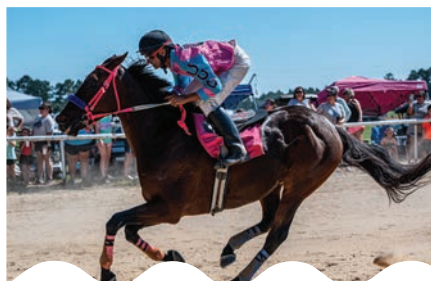

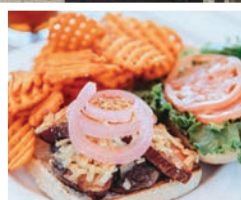

This unique science museum includes two stories of indoor and outdoor exhibits and more than 50 years of NASA history on display. The non-profit, self-guided facility delivers an engaging learning experience for guests of all ages with numerous exhibits that focus on space, but that's not all. The state-of-the-art center also features an immersive blend of space exploration, Earth science, engineering, and technology. Annually, it sees more than 75,000 visitors.

After spending some time in the Immersion Theater, you'll definitely want to check out the second floor where you can explore Biloxi native and NASA Astronaut Fred Haise's Gallery and the Apollo 4 Capsule.

Every facet of this facility is filled with a chance to learn something scientific, even the Infinity CaFe that's spelled out with symbols and abbreviations of elements from the periodic table. The eatery offers items such as a Grilled Cheese Reaction, Cosmos Burger, and Atomic Chicken Club.

Make your plans now to travel to infinity and beyond Wednesdays - Saturdays from 9:00am - 4:00pm (August - May). We will be open Wednesday - Sunday from 10:00am - 5:00pm June and July. One step inside and you'll see, INFINITY Science Center is dedicated to unveiling the sights, sounds, textures, and smells of great past discoveries, and offers a rare glimpse at future missions into uncharted territories.

100 Men Hall

The 100 Men Hall represents a notable structure, a rare architectural monument to African American life on the Gulf Coast and is one of the few standing sites on the Mississippi Blues Trail.

The 501(c)(3) nonprofit—still using the name “Hundred Members Debating Benevolent Association”—returns the Hall to a meaningful role in the community, with the intention of forming a bridge between its original mission and the current needs of the community. The Hall serves as a living heritage museum that carries the unique cultural and musical history particular to the Gulf Coast into the 21st



Century. Those familiar with the Hall consider it a beloved community treasure; those learning about it for the first time are instantly captivated by its storied past.

The Hall was built in June 1922 and was dedicated in July 1923. The dedication is inscribed in a cornerstone still visible on the front right footing. Having survived Camille (1969), Katrina (2005) and Zeta (2020), the Hall celebrated its centennial (2022) with community events to engage people of all ages in its history, significance and mission.

The 100 Men Hall’s mission is to promote and preserve the music, art, historical legacy and culture of the 100 Men Hall, a centuries-old nexus of social justice and artistic expression. Founded in 1894 for and by a population historically denied access to exhibition venues, the Hall is one of very few remaining landmarks within the famed Chitlin Circuit. The Hall’s enduring success is a powerful testament of art’s role as a vehicle for activism.

Over many decades, the Hall sheltered and inspired culture bearers to defy and endure the

chokehold of the Jim Crow South. Today, the hall fosters civic participation in a variety of causes to promote the greater common good, supporting creative expression and activist art for women and men who have struggled to find a mainstream connection due to their social or artistic convictions, or minority status.

Many of us don't realize the importance of preservation until we see it firsthand in our own communities. Preservation reaches so far beyond simply maintaining a building's exterior or erecting a plaque to commemorate forgotten culture-bearers—it tells stories, honors legacies, shapes neighborhoods, uplifts communities, and cultivates the next generation of leaders. And it's especially vital to reach and amplify the voices of artists in even the most rural and isolated places where significant Black history has occurred, which have all too often been overlooked and under recognized for their role in shaping American culture.

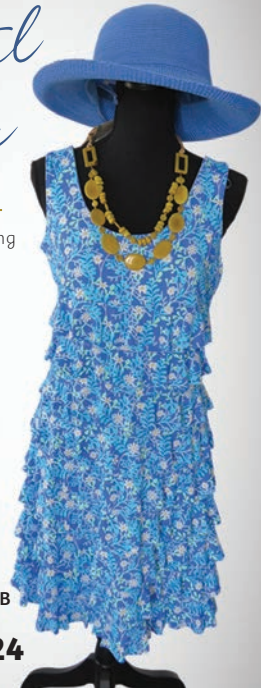


